Adolphe de Rothschild Foundation Hospital

Founded in 1905 in the 19th district of Paris, the Adolphe de Rothschild Foundation Hospital is a private health institution of collective interest (ESPIC) specialized in all pathologies of the head and neck for adults and children.

This university hospital offers excellent care at a conventional rate (non-profit) and treats over 400,000 patients every year. It provides the continuum of care, research, and training, conducts 150 clinical research studies, publishes nearly 400 scientific articles, and training around 900 students each year. The hospital is regularly ranked among the best hospitals in France and worldwide and received the "High Quality of Care" distinction from the French High Authority for Health in 2025, with the highest national score.

Care for patients with diabetes, endocrine disorders, spinal diseases, or chronic inflammatory rheumatism. Also includes cardiology and geriatrics.

Neurology

Care for diseases of the central and peripheral nervous system (e.g., Multiple Sclerosis, Parkinson's, Alzheimer's), management of strokes and neuro-visual and cognitive disorders.

Interventional Neuroradiology (adults & children)

Treatment of vascular brain and spinal cord malformations (aneurysms, vein of Galen, retinoblastoma...).

Neurosurgery (adults & children)

- Management of intracranial and spinal pathologies, Parkinson's, and movement disorders.
- Treatment of refractory pain through a dedicated surgical-medical center.
- Management of refractory epilepsy, severe dystonia, cancers, and endocrine conditions.

Psychiatry

 Expertise in mood disorders, psychotic disorders, and neurodevelopmental disorders.

INITIAL AND CONTINUING EDUCATION

Advancements in brain imaging, genomics, robotic surgery, and the emergence of artificial intelligence in healthcare are opening up entirely new treatment pathways.

The Rothschild Foundation Hospital is fully engaged in this evolution, leveraging its highly specialized medical expertise and cutting-edge clinical research. It also invests in state-of-the-art equipment: MRI scanners, mobile operating room CT scanner, surgical robot Rosa... Under the label "Rothschild Medical Development", the hospital supports project developers through startup creation, funding and partnership opportunities...



INITIAL AND CONTINUING EDUCATION

• University teaching: With a university hospital partnership agreement with Université Paris Cité, the Rothschild Foundation Hospital contributes each year to the initial training of nearly 150 medical residents and numerous externs in medicine and surgery.

- University and inter-university diplomas co-managed with Université Paris Cité: 8 diplomas followed by nearly 400 students each year, including non-medical staff.
- Other continuing education programs: e-learning platform, simulation-based training, international practitioner training, workshops, lunch & learn sessions, and the "Transmit and Innovate in Orthoptics" training.
